| AID-01 & 01b | Location: Guinea (Coleman) | Nurses | Female/Male |
| This is for those who already have the R.N. degree. Assist with the medical needs of outlying villages. Also participate and sometimes lead out in family worship, do some gardening and other tasks as seem appropriate. | | | |
| AID-02 | Location: Guinea (Coleman) | Homeschool Teacher | Female |
| Homeschool Rebecca, Chelcie, and Fred (9-year-old son of contract workers). Prepare and teach classes and read to them. Assist in creative learning, including lots of hands-on activities. School activities 3-5 hrs per day should be enjoyable for the children. They need to learn their appropriate grade-level activities. Also participate in family worship, sermons, do some gardening and and other tasks as seem appropriate. | | | |

SM/TM will also be asked to participate and lead out in family worship, do some gardening, and do other tasks as needed. | Assist with office work (typing, keeping schedules, bookkeeping, and correspondence) four-six hours per day. Type translated materials into Bambara. Key financial info into Quicken and prepare regular reports. Type minutes, reports, research info., and professional communication. Keep files up to date. Print/copy as needed. May be single or married for this call but must have a strong personal devotional and prayer life.

Give health care in the village, write up health topics for radio programs, develop a health curriculum for the local lay worker, spend time helping out at the local hospital, and teach local believers better health. May be an R.N., be experienced in health care, or just have a strong desire to learn from some of the books the Polleys have on hand and put the teachings into practice.

- SSD-09** **Location:** Palawan, Philippines (George) **Maintenance/Community Development** **Male**
- Maintenance of all buildings, radios, electrical equipment, cars, motorcycles, and other equipment. Will also be involved in transport of supplies into project; help and support in the event of medical evacuation. There will also be opportunities for outreach in the village and surrounding villages. We need someone who is dedicated to bringing Christ to the Palawanos. Needs to enjoy rugged lifestyle, i.e. backwoods camping and hiking. Project requires a 2-3 hour hike into the mountains. Will live in a bamboo and grass hut and cook on a two-burner stove.
- SSD-10** **Location:** Palawan, Philippines (George) **Logistical Support Person** **Male**
- Maintenance of houses in lowlands, coordination of purchasing and transport of supplies into project as well as transportation of evacuated patients to the hospital, maintenance of project vehicles and help in emergency situations. SM/TM will also visit individuals in leadership positions for good P.R. Requires extreme flexibility, ability to keep track of money received and spent, and a willingness to meet challenges. Must be a minimum of 25 years of age and willing to stay at least 2 years. Students in this position will get to do friendship evangelism also.

SSD-11 **Location:** Thailand (Wilson) **Homeschool Teacher** **Female**

Homeschool daughter Benya, 9 (4th grade) and son Elijah, 6 (1st grade). Educational background preferable, but not necessary; previous child care experience helpful. Assist the missionaries as needed. Must have spiritual discernment, a prayer life, and the ability to open up to others. There will be opportunities to sit and “talk” with the Mien people also.

SSD-12 **Location:** Thailand (Holbrook) **Resource Center Caretakers** **Retired Couple**

SSD-13 **Location:** Palawan, Philippines (George) **Literacy Teacher** **Female/Male**

SSD-14 **Location:** Palawan, Philippines (George) **Outreach/Development** **Male**

Develop relationships in outlying villages with an eye to opening new work in the area. The SM/TM would team up with a Palawano Adventist. He will be expected to do first-aid and treat primary malaria cases. He will also look for ways that community development projects can help the standard of living in the area. Literacy program is another area that will more than likely be started, eventually to develop Bible study groups and church formation. SM/TM will also be expected to participate in the team meetings in Kemantian and cooperate and coordinate with the church programs there.

EUD-01 **Location:** Turkey (Hope) **Creative Evangelism Consultant** **Male**

Help establish a school of discipleship for future SM/TMs while you befriend and nurture the people around you. May do English instruction and/or other forms of outreach as well as study the Turkish language and culture.

EUD-02 **Location:** Turkey (Hope) **Creative Evangelism Consultant** **Male**

Help establish a school of discipleship for future SM/TMs while you befriend and nurture the people around you. May do English instruction and/or other forms of outreach as well as study the Turkish language and culture.

TED-01 **Location:** Albania (Hendrickson)* **English teacher/Evangelism** **Female/Male**

Teach English as a second language and offer language labs for local language teachers as a tool to build relationships with the people and thus provide opportunities to share the Gospel. This may be in several contexts – with adults as well as younger people. SM/TMs will network with existing teachers among the national to serve and enhance their work and teach English classes as well as provide communication practice time for students.

TED-02 **Location:** Albania (Hendrickson)* **English teacher/Evangelism** **Female/Male**

Teach English as a second language and offer language labs for local language teachers as a tool to build relationships with the people and thus provide opportunities to share the Gospel. TED-03 **Location:** Albania (Hendrickson)* **Lifestyle Educator** **Female/Male**

SM/TM will interact with Albanian families in directed ways with the express objective of building relationships and introducing Christ as the Savior. They will participate in developing and implementing short educational programs which may include: how to stop smoking, personal hygiene, practical health and dietary considerations, first aid, and any other practical skills the SM/TM may possess. They will assist with small groups in the Albanian language as well as gardening and meal preparation and a limited number of short-term community improvement projects

TED-04 **Location:** Greece (Martin) **Friendship Evangelist** **Male from Europe**

Be a university student and live in the dorm while studying the Greek language (your current school must participate in the Erasmus Program, similar to an exchange student program, to avoid visa problems). Must be confident, discreet, balanced, self-motivated, and willing to spend two years as a student making friends and influencing them for Christ. An understanding of Orthodox mindset desirable. Contact with the career family will be occasional outside of Sabbaths so as not to arouse suspicion. Must be able to travel to U.S. for training the summer before mission begins.

NSD-01 **Location:** Creative Access Country+ **Muslim Evangelism via Private English Tutoring** **Female/Male**

Live in your own apartment, possibly with another student missionary, and enjoy the flexibility of being responsible for your own schedule and cooking. Make friends with the local university students or others in the town. Learn their language from a language tutor at the local college. Answer their questions about new English words. Spend lots of time with them and share the light of the Gospel in ways they can accept and understand as God opens the way. SM/TM will be an undercover missionary growing their friendship and witnessing skills by experience. *Must apply with AFM by January 1, 2006, at the latest to be accepted at the Youland university.*
