Terrain (rocky, mountainous, slippery, etc.)

Communications (phone, email, how far is it to the nearest phone?, etc.)

Transportation (bus, taxi, walking, how to you get to your project?, etc.)

Residential (shopping, living environment, etc.)

Resources (clean water, groceries, electricity, running water, etc.)

Cultural (describe the people: educated, superstitious, primitive, etc.)

Inter-relational (between the SM/TM and Career family)

Political climate (hostile, quiet, etc.)
